## **BRIEF INSTRUCTIONS FOR MEASURING MUSKOX**

Measurements must be made with a flexible steel tape or steel cable and recorded to the nearest one-eighth of an inch. To simplify addition, please enter fractional figures in eighths and in proper fractions. Refer to **P & Y Measurer's Manual** for a detailed description of measuring procedures.

- A. Greatest Spread is measured between perpendiculars, at right angles to the center line of the skull.
- B. Tip to Tip Spread is measured between tips of horns.
- **C. Length of Horn** is measured along center of upper horn surface, staying within curve of horn as illustrated, to a point in line with tip. Attempt to free the connective tissue between the horns, at the center of the boss, to determine the lowest point of horn material on each horn near the top center of the skull. Hook the tape under the lowest point of the horn, and measure the length of the horn, with the measurement line maintained in the center of the upper surface of horn, following the converging lines to the horn tip.
- **D-1 Width of Boss** is measured with calipers or squares at greatest width of the boss, with measurement line forming a right angle with horn axis. It is helpful to measure **D-1** before **C**, marking the midpoint of the boss as the correct path of **C**.
- D-2 Width at First Quarter. Divide measurement C of LONGER horn by four. Starting at base, mark BOTH horns at these quarters (even though other horn is shorter). Then, using calipers or squares, measure width of the horn at the first quarter location. Make sure the measurement is perpendicular to the surface of horn, and does NOT include boss material.
- **D-3-4 Circumferences.** Circumference measurements are taken at second and third quarters with measurements being taken at right angles to horn axis. Circumference measurements must be taken with a steel tape (a cable cannot be used for these measurements).

## **ENTRY REQUIREMENTS**

- 1. Original scoring form completed by an Official Measurer of the Pope & Young Club or the Boone & Crockett Club.
- 2. Completed Fair Chase Affidavit.
- **3. Three photos of antiers, horns, or skull** (a view from the front side, a view from the left side and a view from the right side). A field photo is also requested, if possible.
- 4. \$40.00 recording fee (made payable to the Pope and Young Club)

**Drying Period**: To be eligible for entry in the Pope & Young Records, a trophy must first have been stored under normal room temperature and humidity for at least 60 days after date of kill. No trophy will be considered which has been altered in any way from its natural state.
